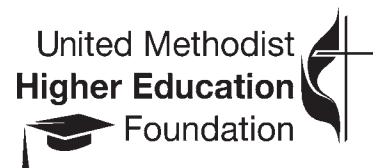

The United Methodist Leadership Scholars (UMLS) program, initiated by the 2004 Jurisdictional Conference of the Southeastern Jurisdiction (SEJ) and select United Methodist-related higher education institutions in the SEJ, is designed to encourage active United Methodist students to attend a United Methodist-related college or university by offering up to \$3,000 in scholarship funds. It is hoped that the transformational experiences available at our United Methodist colleges and universities will guide students to make vocational choices for Christian service to church and society and that these students will emerge as leaders, lay and clergy, of The United Methodist Church.

Through the UMLS program, local churches are encouraged to provide \$1,000 scholarships on behalf of students planning to enroll in a participating SEJ United Methodist-related college or university. These institutions have agreed to match local church funds for a total award of \$2,000. In addition, the United Methodist Higher Education Foundation (UMHEF) has agreed to provide an additional \$1,000 matching scholarship for 100 applicants for a total award of \$3,000 (local church, UMHEF, and school funds).

- This is a point-of entry scholarship only. Applications may be submitted only by students who are first time enrollees in a UM-related college or university. Applicants must also be active members of The United Methodist Church (for at least one year) planning to enroll full-time as an undergraduate in fall 2010 at a **participating United Methodist-related college or university located in the SEJ of The UMC**. Students may submit only one application.
- A check for \$1,000 payable to UMHEF **from the sponsoring church** must be mailed along with the fully completed application form. Churches may submit an unlimited number of applicants for this scholarship program. Please note that churches submitting funds agree to allow the educational institution an opportunity to present the scholarship to the student at the church. Ineligible and incomplete applications will be returned unfunded to the sponsoring church along with the church check.
- UMHEF matching funds are available for up to 100 applicants. Eligible applicants who do not receive matching funds from the UMHEF will still be eligible for a \$1,000 match from the educational institution.
- After verification of full-time enrollment for the fall 2010 semester, UMHEF will transfer \$2,000 to the school (church and UMHEF funds) if the student was awarded UMHEF matching funds **OR** if the student was not awarded UMHEF matching funds, UMHEF will transfer \$1,000 (church funds) to the school. Students should expect to receive an additional \$1,000 matching award directly from their school.
