CRITERIA:

- Must be a member of The United Methodist Church
- Must be attending or planning to attend a UM-related college, university, or seminary.
- Additional criteria may apply.

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS

The **United Methodist Dollars for Scholars** program begins with a \$1,000 scholarship from your United Methodist church. The award may then be matched by UMHEF, participating United Methodist-related schools, and participating UMC conference foundations. Award may total up to \$4,000. Funds are limited at each matching level; awards and totals are not guaranteed.

The **General Named Endowed Scholarship** program includes awards of various amounts from named scholarship funds established by various donors. In addition to basic eligibility requirements, some funds have additional criteria (i.e., resident of specific conference, majoring in specified field, etc.) students must meet in order to be considered. We will match you with the award(s) for which you are most eligible based on your application.

- Students preparing for chaplaincy in US Military
